Why do people *love* Gigi Skizza™ Kits for home?

- Making a Gigi Skizza™ at home provides an easy opportunity to get kids involved with meal preparation.

What types of Skizza™ does Gigi sell in kits?

- The classic Margherita: Gigi Tomato Sauce, basil, oregano, mozzarella
- Add your preferred toppings

What are some of the uses for Skizza™?

- A meal for 1 or 2. Perfect with a side salad or even topped with a salad.
- An appetizer or snack for 3 to 4.
- Tasty and easy hors d’oeuvres when sliced into smaller pieces.

Can Skizza be reheated? Definitely, 3 to 4 minutes in a preheated conventional or toaster oven should do it.

Can toppings, other than those provided by Gigi, be added? Sure! Be creative. Toppings are unlimited and can be multi ethnical, festive, and seasonally relevant. Pesto (any kind!) makes a great sauce/base.

Why are they called Skizza™? There is no leavening, so they’re technically not pizza (FYI: great for Passover). Also plays on the concept – skinny (thin crusted) pizza.

Is Skizza™ healthy? They are lighter and contain fewer calories (by weight and by unit) than traditional pizza. A full Skizza™ shell will set up back only 430 calories! The provided toppings are top quality and are assembled over the Skizza™ in a ratio that allows both toppings and crust to shine rather than weighing down the Skizza™. A delicious and crispy gluten free version is available!
